"Human Factors in Forensic Engineering for the Subrogation Professional"

During this webinar, attendees will be given an introduction to human factors in forensic engineering. Along with a brief history, the basic concepts of human factors will be introduced. The presenters will discuss the application of human factors to design, manufacturing, and assembly. Then human factors will be discussed in context of causation or cause analysis. We will conclude with examples of human factors in forensic engineering analysis, and introduce human factors mistake.
